What is the Cost?	<p>The cost is \$85.00 Which must be a check/money order made out to the Borough of Aspinwall</p>
What does this include?	<p>One 24 x 36 banner to be displayed by the borough. (Banners are two-sided honoring two service persons) Web presence on the Aspinwall Hometown Heroes website page (troopbanners.com) Two 12 x 18 banners for sponsor use. Additional 12 x 18 banners are available for \$20.00 each.</p>

It is important to note that service stars, unlike the Bronze Star, are not individual medals.**
