
The Aspinwall Civil Service Commission is currently waiting for Borough Council to appoint up to three Alternate Commissioners.

1/31/2022: The Aspinwall Civil Service Commission met. Bob McCarthy announced his term was ending, and he would be stepping down as Chairperson that evening. The Commission nominated and unanimously approved Edmond Watters to assume the Chairperson role. Beth Ruff would take the Vice Chairperson position contingent upon formal swearing in by Mayor Joseph Noro. Tripp Clarke will continue his role as Secretary, which was unanimously approved.
